Chronic fatigue syndrome (CFS), also known under its original name myalgic encephalomyelitis (ME), is a chronic systemic illness of yet unexplained etiology and often postviral onset, which is characterized by a substantial intolerance of both physical and cognitive exertion, several neurological and immunological symptoms, and a pathological level of chronic fatigue.

The webinar aims to present contemporary knowledge and up-to-date information about the epidemiology, pathophysiology, and possible therapy of chronic fatigue syndrome and to discuss differential diagnostics approach enabling to distinguish it from other fatiguing conditions.

The webinar takes place under the official auspices of the Minister of Health of the Czech Republic. Translation of the foreign talks to the Czech language will be provided. Translation from Czech to English will not be available.
